I, Louis J. Schwartzberg, Esquire, being duly sworn, depose and state as follows:


1. I am an attorney at the law firm of Pepper Hamilton LLP, 3000 Two

Liquidator of Reliance Insurance Company ("Reliance").


3. We represent the Statutory Liquidator in connection with the Petition to
