
ORDER

AND NOW, this 9th day of November 2006, upon consideration of the agreement of the parties as expressed in their Joint Petition for Amended Scheduling Order, the Petition is GRANTED and the following schedule shall govern:

1. All dispositive motions shall be filed within thirty (30) from the date this court rules on any discovery motions now pending, and any discovery order is completed.
2. All responses to dispositive motions shall be filed within thirty (30) days of the motion to which they respond.
3. All replies to responses to dispositive motions shall be filed within fourteen (14) days of the filing of the response to which they reply.

4. The Court will set a date for hearing this matter before the Court or shall refer the matter to a referee upon resolution of all dispositive motions.

No service requirement accompanies this Order.
