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**RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO LISA MCCLINTOCK'S  
PETITION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY**

M. Diane Koken, the Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as Liquidator for Reliance Insurance Company ("Liquidator") opposes Lisa McClintock's Petition for Relief from Stay of the action captioned Lisa McClintock v. Pavilion Partners, et al., Court of Common Pleas of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania at Docket No. GD 97-11120 ("McClintock Case"). Pursuant to this Court's October 3, 2001 order placing Reliance in liquidation ("Liquidation Order"), all proceedings in which Reliance is obligated to provide defense are stayed for 90 days. Order at ¶ 23. The McClintock Case is a proceeding in a Pennsylvania court in which Reliance has been providing defense and, therefore, is a case that is subject to the 90 day stay order. As this Court has ordered, a 90-day stay of the case is necessary to permit the claim file to be transferred to the appropriate guaranty association for handling.

WHEREFORE, the Liquidator requests that this Court enter an order denying McClintock's petition for relief from stay.

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
