ORDER

AND NOW, this 17th day of January 2008, after reviewing the Liquidator's Petition for First Interim Distribution, and concluding that the Petition is in the best interest of the Estate of Reliance Insurance Company, and further, noting that there have been no objections to the Petition; accordingly,

1. The Liquidator's Petition for First Interim Distribution Petition granted;
2. The First Interim Distribution Percentage for 20% of NOD allowed amounts is APPROVED for all class (b) claimants whose NOD is approved by the Court;
3. For the First Interim Distribution and all future distributions, claims under Aggregate Policies will be handled pursuant to this Court's Order of November 19, 2007;



4. The Liquidator shall issue checks based on the First Interim Distribution Percentage to class (b) claimants whose NODs are approved by the Court subsequent to the First Interim Distribution;

5. For the First Interim Distribution and all future distributions except the final distribution, the Liquidator need not issue a check for less than \$10 per claimant;

6. Within 90 days of the First Interim Distribution, the Liquidator shall inform the Court by way of Petition that the First Interim Distribution has been completed and shall include in that Petition a list detailing to whom payment was made and the amount of said payment;

Finally, the Liquidator is directed to serve a copy of this Order upon all listed on the Master Service List.
