
MEMORANDUM and ORDER

AND NOW, this 12th day of June, 2008, upon consideration of the Liquidator's Petition to Compel Deposition and for Sanctions in the matter of Palm Springs General Hospital, the Court concludes the objections to the Petition are without merit, and the imposition of sanctions is not warranted.

Accordingly, the petition to compel deposition is GRANTED; the petition for sanctions is DENIED.

AND FURTHER, Palm Springs General is directed to file with the Court no later than 3:00 PM June 16, 2008, the name and contact information of its corporate designee; on or before June 23, 2008, Palm Springs General is directed to produce its corporate designee for deposition in Philadelphia at the location determined by the Liquidator.

The Liquidator is directed to serve a copy of this Order upon those listed on the Master Service List and file with this Court no later than 2:00 PM June 13, 2008 an affidavit stating that service has been effectuated.
