ORDER

And now, this 24th day of June, 2009, upon consideration of Republic West Insurance Company's Petition to File the Confidential Arbitration Materials and the Award under Seal; consideration of the Liquidator's agreement that the Materials and Award should be under seal; and, recognizing countervailing public interests in maintaining transparency in the judicial process as well as the consequent need to establish good cause for granting such a request, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**, that each party shall file, no later than 15 days following the date of this Order, a memorandum setting forth grounds justifying the request with respect to each exhibit that is the subject of their request. The memorandum shall provide information beyond the broad averments of the petition, which are unsubstantiated by specific examples or articulated reasoning, to address not only the parties' interests in privacy and the alleged prejudice that may result from public access but also the reasons why the parties' interests in this regard outweigh the public interest.
