ORDER

AND NOW, this 6th day of October, 2010, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED**

as follows:

1. This Court finds that Objector Breaux Bros. Enterprises failed to comply with the terms of the letter dated July 21, 2010 from Chief Clerk Michael F. Krimmel to Maurice C. Hebert, Jr., counsel for Breaux Bros. Enterprises, which was filed with this Court and which advised that “If a motion for admission pro hac vice and Breaux Bros. Enterprises’ perfected objections are not filed within thirty days of the date of this letter, this matter will be considered abandoned and will be dismissed.”

2. FURTHER, by letter dated August 4, 2010, Breaux Bros. Enterprises' counsel responded to the Chief Clerk's July 21, 2010 letter, that Breaux Bros. Enterprises had determined not to incur any further expense associated with hiring Pennsylvania counsel or seeking admission pro hac vice.

3. Consequently, any objection of Breaux Bros. Enterprises to the Notice of Determination issued with respect to Proof of Claim #594819 is DISMISSED.

3. FURTHER, the Liquidator's class (b) Notice of Determination for \$0 issued as to Proof of Claim #594819 is hereby APPROVED.

Counsel for the Liquidator is directed to serve a copy of this Order upon Breaux Bros. Enterprises' counsel.
