




establish abbreviated procedures for the presentation of facts and evidence relating to disputed claims;

set limited discovery schedules should discovery be necessary, and

make recommended findings of fact and conclusions of law for review of the Court.

The compensation for such referees shall be set by the Court at the rate of \$185 per hour, and shall be paid by the Liquidator from the Estate of Reliance Insurance Company. The Court shall continue to use as referees those individuals previously appointed by the Court in the matter of *M. Diane Koken, Insurance Commissioner of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania v. Fidelity Mutual Fire Insurance Company*, 389 M.D. 1992.

**FURTHER**, the Liquidator through her counsel, is hereby directed to serve a copy of this order, forthwith, upon all parties listed on the master service list via U.S. mail and, where designated, fax and/or e-mail and to file with the court in the Office of the Prothonotary, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor the Widener Building, 1339 Chestnut Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107, by 3:00 p.m. February 13, 2002, an affidavit, that service, as outlined above, has been effectuated.
