1. Court approval shall be required prior to the sale and/or transfer of any and all assets of Reliance Insurance Company.

2. The Court directs M. Diane Koken, in her capacity as Rehabilitator of Reliance Insurance Company, to seek Court approval prior to selling, transferring, or encumbering the title of any and all property of Reliance Insurance Company, including but not limited to the sale of real estate, sale of stock, the liquidation of bank accounts.

3. Approval shall be sought by means of petition filed with the Court, and, where necessary, a request for emergency approval to sell or otherwise dispose of asset(s).

4. The Rehabilitator shall serve a notice of the petition upon all interested persons listed on the Master Service List.

The Rehabilitator, through her counsel, is hereby directed forthwith to serve a copy of this order upon all parties listed on the master service list via fax or email, if possible, and U.S. mail. The Rehabilitator, through her counsel, is directed to file with the Court in the Office of the Prothonotary, 9th Floor, the Widener Building, 1339 Chestnut Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107, by 1:00 p.m. Monday, October 1, 2001, an affidavit attesting that service, as outlined above, has been effectuated.
